Museum of contemporary art(Taipei)

DAY11:

Fort Zeelandia(Tainan)

In 1624 AD, the Dutch built Taiwan's first castle, "Zeelandia Castle" in Anping, which is now known as Anping Castle. It was once the center of Dutch rule and the main hub of foreign trade. The original architectural pattern is divided into a square inner city and a rectangular outer city. In 1661 AD, after Zheng Chenggong came to Taiwan to expel the Dutch, he changed the name of the place to Anping. Therefore, Zeelandia City is also called "Wangcheng" or "Taiwan City", commonly known as Anping Castle, and is the earliest city in Taiwan.

DAY12:

Anping great fort

A combined Dutch military and commercial force conquered present-day Anping in 1624 and established Fort Zeelandia as their defensive stronghold, which was completed in 1634. In 1662, Koxinga successfully recaptured the Dutch fort and renamed it Anping.



DAY13:

The National Taiwan Museum of History

The display here focuses on the history of Taiwan, including the interactions of multi-ethnic groups with Taiwan's natural environment over a long period of time. Additionally, it covers multiple exhibition themes such as Taiwan's foreign relations, the various ethnic groups in Taiwan, and modern Taiwan.
